We Succeed Together is an inclusion and well-being initiative designed to improve the quality of life for individuals with developmental disabilities and their support team.

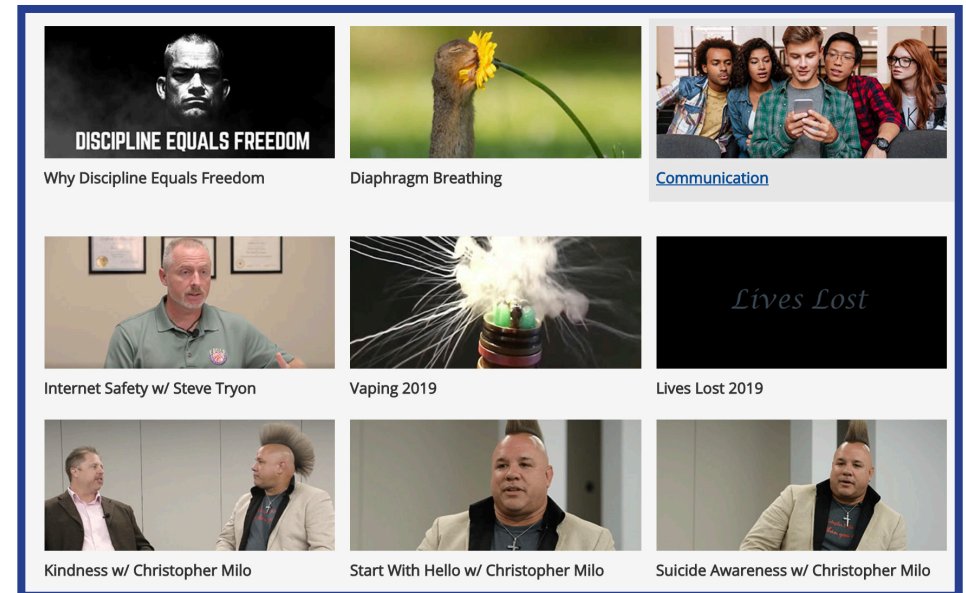

We Succeed Together

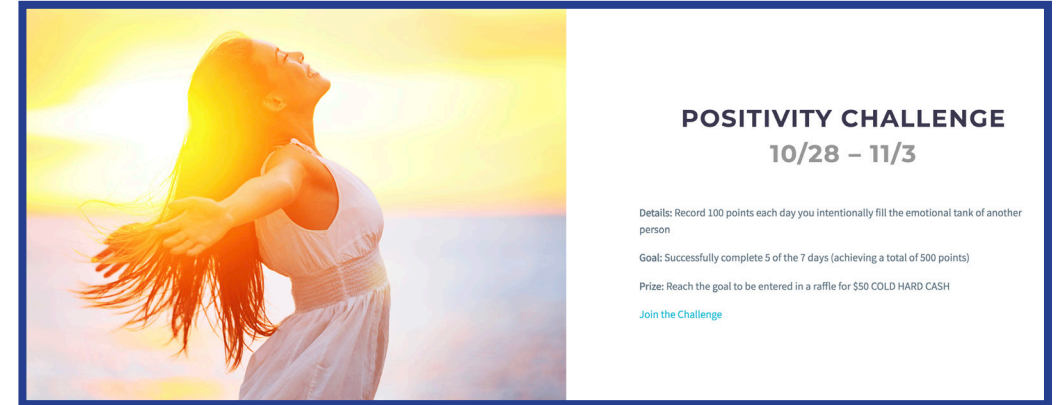
We Succeed Together provides programming and services to individuals with developmental disabilities, their family members, caregivers, and team of support professionals. We Succeed Together features:

- **All Choices Matter G.R.I.T.T. Program (Gratitude. Resilience. Integrity. Tolerance. Teamwork.)**
 - » G.R.I.T.T. is designed to help students, teachers, and parents work through some of the issues students face every day, including, but not limited to:
 - **Careers:** Employment, Enrollment, Entrepreneurship, Career Interviews, Workforce Readiness
 - **Character:** Courage, Creativity, Determination, Gratitude, Human Rights, Kindness, Leadership, Perseverance, Self Esteem, Uniqueness
 - **Tough Stuff:** Abuse, Addiction, Bullying, Conflict Resolution, Cyber Safety, Mental Health, Money, Safety, Self Improvement, Sexting, Stress, Suicide

- **hChoices Wellness Program**
 - » Inspires, engages, and most importantly, motivates individuals to take back control of their health. It includes HIPAA compliant health monitoring/tracking, assessments, surveys, wellness challenges, classes, presentations, and support groups.



- **Digital Mosaic Video Storytelling**
 - » Gives individuals a way to record, store and share their personal stories. Storytelling is a unique way for individuals to develop an understanding, respect and appreciation for others. Telling, listening to and sharing stories helps build strong relationships and sense of empathy.

- **13 Messages from Milo Virtual Mentoring Program**
 - » Be Positive, Be Genuine, Accept, Love One Another, Listen, Communicate, Work Together, Be Curious, Inspire, Coach, Use Your Talents, Be Creative, Trust
 - Small ideas in small groups become life changing opportunities for everyone
 - Improves culture, morale, self-esteem, and confidence
- **Leadership Summits**
 - » Engage and inspire individuals to be positive change agents, to be passionate, and to take charge of their future
 - » Leaders present what leadership means in them and how they overcame adversity that transformed them into leaders
 - » Free, full-day conference with attendance goal of 500+
